Adding suffixes  
beginning with  
vowels

-ed -ing

-er -est -y

For this rule, y is classed as an honorary vowel.

When a root word ending in y has more than one syllable, change the y to i (happiest, lazier, funniest).

When a root word ends with e, remove the e before adding the suffix (copied, bravest, larger).

When a root word ends in a short vowel and consonant, double the consonant (fatter, biggest).
